What personal information do we collect from the people who become members of Mutts On A Mission?

When do we collect information?

We collect information from you when you apply for membership on our site or via filing application paperwork, fill out a form or enter information.

How do we use your information?

We may use the information we collect from you when you apply to follow up with you on matters pertaining to your membership (such as maintaining current records, dues, and volunteer opportunities) and the organization as a whole (such as meetings, minutes, reports, etc.)

How do we protect your information?

We do not use vulnerability scanning and/or scanning to PCI standards. We do use third party software, specifically PayPal, to collect funds for annual dues and donation. PayPal is meet all PCI standards.

Your personal information is contained behind secured networks and is only accessible by a limited number of persons who have special access rights to such systems, and are required to keep the information confidential. In addition, all sensitive/credit information you supply is encrypted via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology.

Do we use 'cookies'?

We do not use cookies for tracking purposes

You can choose to have your computer warn you each time a cookie is being sent, or you can choose to turn off all cookies. You do this through your browser settings. Since browser is a little different, look at your browser's Help Menu to learn the correct way to modify your cookies.
